What can be cleaned using soft wash (bleach)?

Virtually any surface* with mold, mildew, algae, fungus, moss, lichen, and bacteria. Bleach kills these organisms and delays their reappearance, resulting in longer intervals between treatments than cleaning with only water. *An inconspicuous area should be tested first to ensure compatibility.

Is spraying bleach harmful to humans/pets?

Precaution should always be taken when using any household cleaning product. Bleach is safe when used as directed.

Will bleach harm vinyl siding or asphalt roof surfaces?

No. In fact, the Vinyl Siding Institute and the Asphalt Roofing Manufacturers Association both recommend bleach to clean mold/algae from these surfaces.

Can I soft wash without using Brave Pro Cling Surfactant?
