- Make sure that pressure does not exceed 4500 PSI maximum working pressure rated for the accessory.
- Never make adjustments on this accessory while in operation.
- Before connecting hoses, make sure that this accessory is installed properly.
- Be certain all connections are secure and inspect for leaking before using pressure washer.



⚠ DANGER: RISK OFINJURY FROM SPRAY

- Always wear safety glasses or goggles and appropriate clothing.
- Never point the high-pressure discharge at a person, any part of the body or animals.
- Keep operating area clear of all persons.
- Do not allow children to operate this product. Do not use around children. This product must be attended during operation.



- Maximum water temp is 212°F.
 Water must be clean fresh water.
- Do not operate gasoline engines in a confined area; always have adequate ventilation.

ASSEMBLY AND USE

⚠ WARNING: To reduce the risk of injection or injury, only use the surface cleaner on flat, horizontal surfaces. Never lift the surface cleaner from the cleaning surface while operating the pressure washer.

- 1. Bolt the two halves of the handle together with the two bolts, nuts and four washers.
- 2. Connect the handle to the brackets on the deck with the two long pins and rings.
- 3. Connect the hose to the swivel on the deck. Ensure sealant tape is applied to the hose fitting and connection is secure.
- 4. Attach the brass in-line filter body to the inlet of the gun. The filter is located inside this brass body. Ensure selant tape is applied to the fitting and connection is secure. The filter must always be installed when using this product. Operating without a filter may cause damage to product.
- 5. Connect your pressure washer hose to the in-line filter. Use the provided QC plug if needed.
- 6. Prior to starting pressure washer, turn water on and squeeze gun trigger. Ensure nozzles have flowing spray. If not, nozzles may need to be cleaned. See Nozzle Maintenance section below.
- 7. Start your pressure washer as described in your pressure washer manual.
- 8. Walk slowly behind the cleaning deck, cleaning as you go.

NOTE: If striping or swirling occurs, slow your pace. If striping or swirling continues, the surface cleaner nozzle, may be clogged. See Nozzle Maintenance section below.

NOTE: Periodically check weep hole on bottom of swivel.

Water will seep slowly; if water shoots out, stop and replace seals.

Swivel assembly can be rebuilt/replaced.

MARNING: Striking any raised obstacle while using the surface cleaner will damage the unit. If contact does occur and causes vibration when operating the pressure washer, stop and discontinue use. Continuing to operate the unit could result in serious injury or damage to the unit.

MAINTENANCE

When shipped, two nozzles are pre-assembled to the surface cleaner. Excessive pump pressure (a pulsing sensation felt while squeezing the trigger and/or a higher vibration in the surface cleaner) may be the result of a clogged or dirty nozzle.

- Turn off the pressure washer and shut off the water supply. With the surface cleaner on the ground, pull trigger to release water pressure.
- Disconnect surface cleaner from pressure washer.
- Using a straightened paper clip or nozzle cleaning tool, free any foreign materials clogging or restricting the nozzle.
- Using a garden hose, flush debris out of nozzle by back flushing (running the water through the nozzle backwards or from the outside to the inside).
 NOTE: Never point the spray bar at your face.
- Reconnect the surface cleaner to the pressure washer.
- Turn on the water supply and start the pressure washer.

In-line filter must be kept clean.

- Turn off the pressure washer and shut off the water supply. With the surface cleaner on the ground, pull trigger to release water pressure.
- Disconnect surface cleaner from pressure washer.
- Remove filter body and filter from surface cleaner inlet.
- Use a brush to free debris and then backflush with water until clean.
- Reinstall the inline filter and filter body to surfance cleaner inlet prior to use. Do no t use without inline filter installed.
